Task 2: Favorite Space Inside or Outside My Home	talk about my favorite spaces inside or outside the home, including details such as what I do there, how these spaces make me feel, and who spends time there with me.

	talk about similarities and differences, say which spaces they like best, and ask questions to elicit further information.	
Task 3: Places Near Where I Live	talk about a place near where I live and explain why it is interesting, unique, or important.	
	exchange information about which places I would like to visit, what else I would like to learn, and whether it reminds me of any places near my own home.	
Task 4: Places To Show a Visitor	plan and present a mini-tour of the place where I live, describing interesting sites or places that are personally relevant to me.	
	effectively interact with my peers to discuss the mini-tours they have presented, say my opinion, and ask questions to elicit further information.	
Task 5: Reflection	talk about my home and describe other places in my local area that are relevant to me.	
	interact effectively with my peers to discuss these topics, including my opinion, talking about similarities and differences, and asking questions to elicit further information.
